The Issuer (“Southbridge”) has entered into a letter agreement to conduct a due diligence review of the proposed business of Vodis Innovative Pharmaceuticals Inc. (“VODIS”). VODIS has made an application to Health Canada to become a Licensed Producer under the Marihuana for Medical Purposes Regulation (“MMPR”) and intends to acquire all of the operating assets (the “Assets”) of 934145 BC Ltd. (“BC Ltd”) which is currently in

production under the previous Health Canada regulations.

Southbridge has loaned an initial \$250,000 to VODIS as it continues the application process. Southbridge is conducting a due diligence review of the business of VODIS and has the right to acquire the business of VODIS, subject to the successful outcome of the review. To acquire VODIS and the business of VODIS the Issuer will advance a further \$250,000 and complete the preparation of formal documentation to acquire VODIS and the assets of BC Ltd.

The acquisition agreement contemplates that the Issuer will change its name to Vodis Pharmaceuticals Inc. and will issue 36 million common shares, subject to an escrow agreement, to the principals of Vodis and acquire the Assets for one dollar and, subject to the issuance of the License, repay the loans outstanding to the shareholders of BC Ltd. in the amount of \$500,000. The acquisition is subject to the satisfaction of standard conditions precedent for a transaction of this nature ("Closing").

The principals of VODIS are arm's length to the Issuer and will continue employment with the Issuer to operate and manage the business subsequent to the Closing of the acquisition.
