Report on Business

1. Provide a general overview and discussion of the development of the Issuer's business and operations over the previous month. Where the Issuer was inactive disclose this fact.

The Company is engaged in artisanal tailings remediation and gold trading focused on Central America with expansion targets across Central and South America. The opportunities for production and trading arise from artisan mine tailings, recycling, private sellers, and internal production in these regions.

In collaboration with the Norman B. Keevil Institute of Mining Engineering at the University of British Columbia, the Company has implemented effective, innovative, and environmentally responsible processing and reclamation technologies.

Following a financing in late November of 2014, Newlox embarked on an expansion program at the Company's first processing centre which, when completed, will increase throughput capability from 40 tonnes per day to 80 tonnes per day, more than doubling gold concentration production.

Newlox's operational team made good progress on the expansion during the first quarter, running testing and optimization programs as part of the final commissioning work at the expanded operation. Final commissioning work and optimization have been underway during the past two months.

Processing systems continued limited operation at the Company's initial processing plant during the expansion process. Gravity and flotation concentration systems continued to prove effective in producing concentrates which are destined for beneficiation in-house. The company is currently processing a roughly 5 tonne concentrate inventory at its beneficiation plant with the intension of starting to deliver gold doré for sale.

Test production has been underway at the beneficiation plant and initial doré production has been achieved. The Newlox team intend to ramp-up from test

production to commercial production rapidly during the current quarter.

In addition, Newlox's reclamation center has successfully begun to remove contamination left in the environment by historical mining in the region. The removal of mercury pollution originating from historical and artisanal mining is a major priority for management and the success seen so far in this area is encouraging.

Management were pleased with the performance of the beneficiation systems during the first and subsequent test runs and the operations team is now devoting their time to optimization in this area.

Management has commissioned a NI 43-101 report on its activities, which will provide investors with additional insight into the Company's operations and opportunities while confirming that the company is not conducting exploration, orebody definition or mining and does not hold mineral properties, resources, or reserves. Work on this report has progressed rapidly and an advanced draft is now under review.

Management has been applying modern processing technologies to existing tailings stockpiles in Latin America to achieve environmental reclamation and precious metals recovery.


