During the month the Company completed the second tranche of a private placement financing of units at a price of five cents per unit for gross proceeds of \$15,750 through the issuance of 315,000 units of the company. Each unit comprises one common share of the company and one common share purchase warrant. Each warrant entitles the holder thereof to purchase one additional common share of the company at a price of 10 cents per common share until June 3, 2017.

In connection with the offering, the company also paid \$787.50 and issued 15,750 broker warrants to certain eligible parties with respect to services provided in connection with the offering. Each broker warrant entitles the holder thereof to purchase one additional common share at a price of 10

cents until June 3, 2017.
