The Issuer paid \$570,000 of \$570,000 owed to Amalgamated Income Limited Partnership in respect of a Promissory Note issued to Amalgamated for a loan, at an interest rate of 4% per annum. The money borrowed from Amalgamated was used to invest in receivable factoring investments from Acorn Partners Merchant Bankers. The money was repaid using proceeds from a Trust set up by the Issuers previous board of directors.

The Issuer had a loan in the amount of \$570,000 from Amalgamated Income LP a company with common Officers and Directors. The interest rate being charged by Amalgamated was 4% annually. This loan was repaid May 2009, after funds were released from a Trust set up by previous Directors of the Issuer.
