## **Agency Agreement Renewal Term Expires**

**VANCOUVER, BC** – September 27, 2013 – AFG Flameguard Ltd, (“AFG” or the “Company”) (CNSX: AFG) announces:

### **Agency Agreement Renewal under Negotiation**

The Company Master Distributor Agreement with DSPA.nl/AFG Group.nl has a three year term ending September 27, 2013 after which it is automatically renewed for one year unless declared in default. The Company was given notice after the opening of trading on September 25<sup>th</sup> that it was in default of its Distributor agreement and accordingly requested a halt in trading to negotiate a resolution.

Negotiation between the boards of the two companies and a specific proposal to renew the existing Distributer agreement for an extended term is under active discussion and the current proposal would be beneficial to both parties but as of close of trading September 26, 2013 has not been concluded.

There is no guarantee the negotiation will be successful and that the default declaration may be withdrawn with a new term granted on the Distributor Agreement. The Company’s sole business consists of the right to sell the state-of-the-art fire suppression products of DSPA.nl and AFG Group.nl so a renewal of the Distribution Agreement is vital to continue operations with this product supplier.

Frans Vogelzangs has resigned as a Director of the Company, the Company wishes to thank Mr. Vogelzangs as a founder and active board member for his service and expects to continue working with him in the event the Distributor agreement is renewed, as he remains a Director of DSPA.nl/AFG Group.nl.
