The Company maintains a modest level of sales from the northern Ontario region mostly from past marketing efforts and expenditures. Activity has been focused on further cost cutting and as of November 1st the companies office in Toronto was closed and products stored there placed in a third party warehouse under a new consignment arrangement with its main supplier AFG.NL. Fires extinguished by volunteer fire crews this month were as follows:

Brant County ON - Nov 4, Successful deployment - Insurance adjuster very impressed on lack of water and damage:

Department was called to the scene of a house fire by neighbours. It was a fire that started in the attic then progressed to kitchen. A neighbour entered the building but exited leaving the door opened which fuelled the fire. The department arrived and deployed the unit into the kitchen and it knocked down the flames on both floors and they only used 50 gallons.

West Lincoln ON- November 25- House fire fully engaged when first responder arrived- Deployed DSPA-5 helped reduce the flames until fire teams arrived but was too advanced to save the house.

West Lincoln ON- Nov 28 First Responder arrived at the scene. Large garage fire deployed the DSPA-5 to slow down the flames from spreading to the house.

Cardigan, Montague and Georgetown PEI - Nov 28, The largest feed service operation in eastern P.E.I. is still standing today because of the expertise of volunteer firefighters, says the manager of the Cardigan Feed Service.

Firefighters from Cardigan, Montague and Georgetown all responded and a DSPA canister was tossed into the burning electrical room upon first arrival. The device

Mapleton Fire Department ON- The first weekend of Dec Fire Fighters attended a basement fire. It is dangerous to attack basement fires. The team deployed an Aerosol Fire Knock down device and dramatically reduced the damage and created a much safer environment to extinguish the fire. The department has replaced the units with a replacement sale.
