As part of his mining related entrepreneurial activities, he founded the Tanzania Mining auto sourcing Company named HERJOS Enterprises and works in many environmental projects around the area with local small miners who has been reliable source of information on mining sites and industry opportunity in Tanzania. In addition, he was a member of numerous parliamentary committees including: Canada-China, Canada-Europe, Canada-Japan, Canada-U.S. and Economic-Missions: Germany, Brussels, Moscow, New Zealand, Holland, and Taiwan. Finally, he was the representative of the Canadian government at the U.N., N.A.T.O. and O.E.C.D.

Mr. Tremblay attended la Sorbonne (Paris, France) and the University of Ljubijana (Yugoslavia) to study Economy and Politic Science. He graduated from Laval University in Quebec City with a Bachelor's degree in Commerce (B.Sc.C.) and a Master's in Accounting (M.Sc.C.) in 1967.

Mr. Tremblay returned to the private sector and created his own firm Le Groupe Marcel R. Tremblay Inc. involved in international and overseas market development for clients as well as mergers, acquisitions and strategic alliances. Mr. Tremblay's world-wide public and private sector experience will be invaluable to Cadman.
