

Glenbriar completes Micro-Aid acquisition

WATERLOO, ON – April 10 2008 — **Glenbriar Technologies Inc.** (CNQ: GBRT) today announced that it had completed the previously announced acquisition of Micro-Aid Computer Services, a private information technology consultancy based in Cambridge, Ontario. Glenbriar issued 150,000 common shares as partial consideration for the purchase. The shares were issued for \$0.10 per share, which was the prior day's closing price on the CNQ. Additional share instalments totaling \$50,000 at market price (subject to a minimum \$0.10 per share) are scheduled to be issued in July and October 2008, and January 2009, subject to final closing adjustments. Glenbriar has retained all staff, and will be consolidating Micro-Aid's infrastructure into Glenbriar's Waterloo location. Additional details will be included in upcoming financial reports.
